

APICS Certification Exams are GI Bill Approved!



The Veterans Administration has re-approved CPIM, CSCP, and CLTD exams as part of the GI Bill certification test fee reimbursement benefit



Veterans and Dependents may be eligible to receive up to \$2,000 in test fee reimbursement assistance



Veterans and Dependents should contact their local VA for reimbursement approval prior to purchase



The veteran population was 18.2 million in 2017

APICS Certification Exams are GI Bill Approved

For individuals who are Veterans and Dependents that qualify for the GI Bill, part of their entitlement may be used for up to \$2,000 in APICS exam fee reimbursement.

What your clients and learners should know about test benefits. The VA:

- May reimburse for tests for as many approved licenses or certifications as they'd like.
- May reimburse for tests even if they don't score high enough to get their license or certification. They can take the same test as many times as needed.
- Won't pay for other costs related to getting the actual license or certification document (i.e. registration, preparation guides, etc.)
- Won't pay more than \$2,000 in fees for one test.
- Can't double-dip from GI Bill and Voc Rehab exam benefits or other entitlements

To receive this benefit:

You must be eligible to receive GI Bill or VA benefits so we recommend checking with your local VA first. In most cases, Veterans are expected to pay exam fees first, then [apply for education benefits](#) with the VA for reimbursement.
